TRANSFER OPTIONS

- Completed AA or AS degree: all courses will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis. Having completed an AA/AS degree does not necessarily meet the General Education core at Carthage. However, students with an AA degree are automatically granted junior standing.
- IAI GECC: Carthage is NOT a participant in the IAI.
- Completing some courses at CLC: Students will have to follow Carthage's general education requirements to meet the general education component of the baccalaureate degree.

TRANSFER CREDITS

The maximum number of semester hours transferable from a community college to meet Carthage graduation requirements is 68. Grades of "D" and "F" are not acceptable for transfer credit (will be calculated in determining the cumulative GPA) except for students who have earned an AA or AS.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Transfer Student = 12 college level credit hrs or more; students with less than 12 college level credit hrs must submit official high school transcripts including ACT or SAT scores.

CALCULATION OF ADMISSION GPA

Developmental courses and other nontransferable courses will not be used in calculation of GPA for admission. If a student has repeated a course that is transferable, and the original grade is a D or F, then Carthage will use the 2nd grade in the calculation of GPA. If the student still achieves a D or F on a 2nd attempt, both the 2nd and 3rd achieved grades are used in the calculation. If the first grade of a repeated course is a C or better, Carthage will average the two together.

APPLICATION

Rolling Admissions but an early application is encouraged. Financial aid awarding for fall transfers typically begins in March for the following fall term. We strongly recommend filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by February 15. (Carthage FAFSA school code=003839)

FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

There is no foreign language requirement for admission, however, students are required to complete or test out of two semesters of college foreign language, consecutive and in the same language in order to graduate.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Competitive scholarships are available for fall and spring entering students (visit www.carthage.edu/transfer for more information). At least one full tuition scholarship and one \$17,000 scholarship is awarded each competition (each renewable for three years). Full time transfer students with a 2.30+ transfer GPA are eligible for a tuition scholarship of \$4000- \$7000, regardless of need. Higher GPAs make a student eligible for a larger scholarship.
