Note: A maximum of 64 semester credits and an additional 4 semester credits in physical education activity courses may transfer from a two-year community or junior college.

Other Graduation Requirements:

1. Students can fulfill NMU's **world cultures** requirement by completing one of the following while at College of Lake County: HST 127, PHI 221, GEG 122, GEG 123, HST 126 ; and
2. At least one course in the Liberal Studies Program must be at the **300-level or above**. This requirement can be completed before attending the university if the transfer student selects a course that transfers at that level. At College of Lake County, the following courses meet this requirement: ENG 223, ENG 228, ENG 229, ENG 263.
