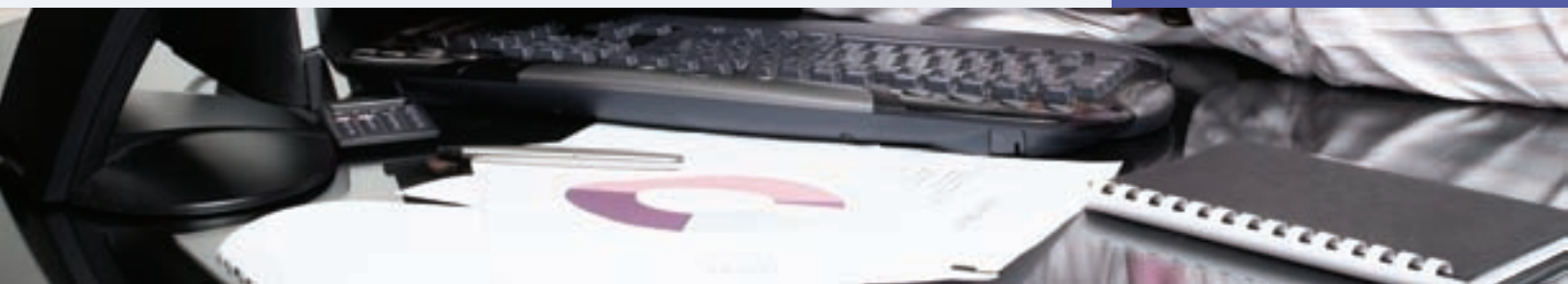

Oracle Database Administrator Students Learn:

- Administrative tasks performed by a database administrator.
- How to design, create, maintain, effectively manage, start up and shutdown and troubleshoot an Oracle database using Oracle administration tools.
- Oracle database architecture and how its components work and interact with one another.
- How to organize a database and how to move data into and between databases under different environments.
- Methods to back up, restore and recover the database given various scenarios.
- Networking concepts and configuration parameters.

How to Register

1. Submit an Application for Admission

Apply at www.clcillinois.edu/apply.asp

2. Learn your CLC Student ID and PIN

When your application has been processed (usually within two working days), you will receive your seven-digit ID number in the mail. Your PIN is initially set to your six-digit date of birth (mmddyy). You will need both the ID and PIN to register.

3: Meet Proficiencies/Prerequisites

The Admissions Office will accept one of the following documents to prove proficiency:

- High school transcript showing class rank in top 1/3
- ACT scores of 17 or above on math and verbal
- SAT scores of 450 on math and verbal tests
- GED transcript showing 550 or above on reading, language and math tests
- U.S. college transcript showing completion of an associates degree or higher, or U.S. college transcript showing completion of 30 credits with no grade less than a 'C'
- Take CLC's Academic Proficiency Test for Language and the Math Placement Test
