## Course Selection & Numbering

### Transfer Courses

- Courses in the transfer category may lead to an A.A., A.A.T., A.F.A., A.S. or A.E.S. degree and usually may be transferred to a four-year institution to apply toward a bachelor's degree.  
*Transfer Course Numbering: 100-299 Middle Digit: 2, 4 or 6*

### Career Courses

- Courses in the career category may lead to an A.A.S. degree or certificate. Some courses may also apply toward an A.A., A.A.T., A.F.A., A.S. or A.E.S. degree. To find out what courses transfer, consult the Counseling Center and/or contact the four-year institution directly.  
*Career Course Numbering: 100-299 Middle Digit: 1, 3, 5 7 or 9*

### Developmental courses

- Courses in the developmental category prepare students for college-level courses in the transfer and career categories. They do not in themselves transfer.  
*Developmental Course Numbering: 100-299 Middle Digit: 0*
