



Telewebs: A self-paced way to take credit courses.

If you:

- can discipline yourself to study independently
- have several hours on a weekly basis to read the text and take notes on teleweb programs
- can work without regular classroom contact with an instructor
- have access to the Internet

... then telewebs are an alternative way to get credit!

What are telewebs?

Telewebs are college credit courses prepared by leading professionals in specific subject areas. Most courses consist of viewing 20-30 videos, together with accessing the information on the Internet, reading the required text and study guide, and completing exams.

Teleweb instruction is an alternate method of learning that allows students to progress at their own pace. This is an ideal non-traditional option for those who would otherwise be unable to attend a scheduled class.

How do you learn about specific course requirements?

Orientation materials are available online or at optional in-person orientation sessions (see schedule below).

The materials include a course outline. Instructors also have regular office hours if a student needs assistance with the course. Texts, study guide materials, and videos can be purchased in the bookstore.

Where do you take tests?

Tests can be taken online or in person in the Learning Assistance Center at the Grayslake Campus, Lakeshore Campus in Waukegan, or at the Southlake Campus in Vernon Hills.
