### **PHARMACY TECHNICIAN TRAINING (5-0) 5 HOURS**

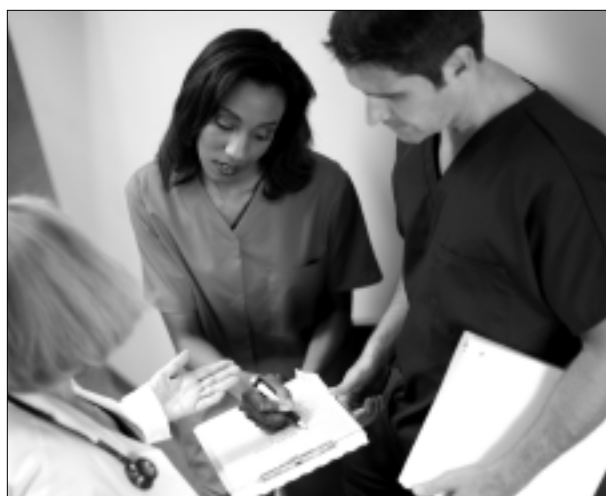
The professional pharmacy technician course is an introductory course that is designed to teach students the fundamentals and specifics of becoming a pharmacy technician.

## **IV THERAPY BASICS**

Designed for the nurse who needs a review or introduction to IV therapy, this course covers venipuncture techniques along with the care, maintenance, complications, and treatments of peripheral IV catheters, midline and PICC lines, short term percutaneously inserted lines, tunneled catheters, and implanted ports. ## **SELECT TOPICS: NURSING CE**

**1 HOUR**

This course is designed to meet the continuing education needs of nurses or other health professionals seeking professional development. Course content will vary depending on the topic being studied. This course may be repeated until taken a total of 4 times but any individual topic may only be taken once.

## **CNA Recertification**

This course is designed for individuals who have already completed the Certified Nurse Assistant course and who have successfully completed the Illinois Nurse Aide Examination, but who no longer are listed on the Illinois Nurse Aide Registry. Students must first contact the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) 217-785-5133 and request a recertification packet. All students in this course will undergo a UCIA criminal background check prior to attending the clinical site. Student will also need to have the required and updated immunizations prior to attending the clinical site. The course will provide recertification of the 21 skills and offer a review for the State Examination.

## **CURRENT NURSING PRACTICE UPDATE (3.5-7)**

**7 HOURS**

This course is designed to update nurses who, for varying reasons, have not been actively involved in nursing practice. Topics covered include: current trends in nursing and health care, legal aspects of nursing, review of basic skills, review of diseases, and selective new nursing techniques. The course also updates the nurse on concepts relevant to nursing across the life cycle to form the focus for theory, clinic, and the simulated nursing labs. This process assists the nurse in reestablishing confidence and competence.

**Note:** RN license and active CPR cards will be collected on the first day of class.
