

Registration Steps for Continuing and Returning Students

STEP 1

Determine if your CLC student record is 'active' at this time.

If you were enrolled in the last two years, your record is active and no Student Information Form is needed.

You are automatically eligible to register. To enroll in classes, you need your CLC ID number and PIN. You can look up your CLC Student ID on the Web at <http://clcillinois.edu/selfserv.asp>. Your PIN is initially set to your date of birth (mmdyyy). Once you have logged in, it is important to change your PIN to 6 digits/characters only you will know.

If you were not enrolled at CLC in the last two years your record is inactive, and you need to reapply.

Please complete a Student Information Form and your record will be updated. If you are planning to complete a degree, you must follow the requirements found in the current catalog, not the catalog from the year of your first admission.

STEP 2

Meet with an Academic Advisor, Counselor or Faculty Advisor in your program of study.

If you have **30 college credit hours or more** and have decided on a career program or plan to earn an Associate in Applied Science degree or certificate, make arrangement to see a faculty advisor by calling the appropriate academic division office (look in the college catalog or on the college's website for your program to find the academic division). If you have **30 college credit hours or more** and are planning to transfer, make arrangements to see a Counselor in the Counseling, Advising and Transfer Center. If you have **less than 30 college credit hours**, make arrangements to see an Academic Advisor or Counselor in the Counseling, Advising and Transfer Center. If you are uncertain about who to see, contact the Counseling, Advising and Transfer Center. Phone and room numbers are listed below.

STEP 3

Select classes, check prerequisites, and register

Select classes and register through the CLC Web Self-Service at www.clcillinois.edu/selfserv.htm or in person at the Grayslake Campus, Lakeshore Campus, or Southlake Campus.

Prerequisites are listed in the course description. See page 143 for information on how to satisfy language proficiency and basic algebra readiness prerequisites.

STEP 4

Pay tuition and fees by the due date

To avoid being dropped from classes for non-payment, you must pay in full or enroll in the college's new installment tuition payment plan by your due date.

Prior to their tuition due date, financial aid applicants must have completed the FAFSA application and demonstrated eligibility in order to be awarded financial aid. If the amount of the financial aid award does not cover the balance due, you must either pay the difference in full, or enroll in the college's installment tuition payment plan by your due date.
