**NOTE:** All pharmacy technicians must be nationally certified by 2010. This course will help to prepare students for both national certification exams.

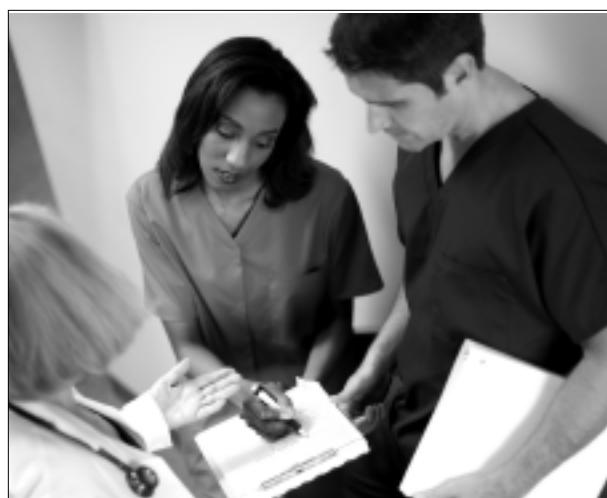
### **PHARMACY TECHNICIAN TRAINING (5-0) 5 HOURS**

#### **CNA Recertification**

This course is designed for individuals who have already completed the Certified Nurse Assistant course and who have successfully completed the Illinois Nurse Aide Examination, but who no longer are listed on the Illinois Nurse Aide Registry. Students must first contact the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) 217-785-5133 and request a recertification packet. All students in this course will undergo a UCIA criminal background check prior to attending the clinical site. Student will also need to have the required and updated immunizations prior to attending the clinical site. The course will provide recertification of the 21 skills and offer a review for the State Examination.

## Massage Therapy Program

CLC can put you in touch with a great career as a massage therapist. The college is offering a credit massage therapy

program that prepares students to take a national certification exam and apply for state licensure after only two semesters of coursework (10 courses) that provide classroom instruction and clinical experience.

This growing field offers employment in a wide variety of settings, including healthcare facilities, spas, and cruise ships. Median hourly earnings for massage therapists are \$15.36, according to the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics. Many massage therapists make their own hours or work in interesting settings, but all of them get the opportunity to see how their work improves peoples' lives in tangible ways.
